91320 members benefited through medical camps conducted across India by various hospitals. In eye camps 58289 members were screened, 365 free cataract operations were perforned and 2360 were provided free reading spectacles.





We Conducted 5 day skill training programme across India for 8521 members on various products like soap oil, soap powder, phenol,tailoring,beautician, embroidering etc. These trainings help supplement income of members. Along with the skill training we also provide health education to members.





Conducted job fairs for members children and facilitated getting gainful employment opportunities to nearly 2135 youth for the month of sep-oct and cumulatively 22963 youth.





26239 members benefited from EDK shops during the month of Sep-Oct. The average purchase by each member was Rs.1690 per month and average savings was around 8-10%. We have added 6466 new members to the total base in the month of September thus taking the total customer base to 131139, Pammal shop topped the sales for the month followed by Purasaiwakkam and Ambathur. The Bio metric identification of members is implemented in all 20 stores.
