SAVING LITTLE HEARTS A CAMPAIGN WITH APOLLO CHILDRENS HOSPITAL, CHENNAI

Encouraged by the success of an earlier camp conducted for the first time at Tiruvarur with Veludayar Kalvi group, wherein 610 children were screened and 32 were found to require immediate cardiac operative intervention, Apollo Childrens Hospital successfully completed the task for 23 children entirely free under TN CM Insurance scheme thus saving them, photo shows a post operative check up camp at Tiruvarur where Dr Anuradha sreedhar is seen with the smiling families and children after full recovery













During Sept, a similar camp was organised at Pudukottai with Sudarshan Efucational Trust and Apollo on 6th Sept. Nearly 230 children were screened and 20 were diagnosed for immediate corrective intervention. The District Collector Mr Ganesan IAS who visited the camp organised to issue TN CM insurance card to all eligible beneficiaries and from this camp so far 12 have received treatment successfully
